Dear provider of healthcare-related services,

On May 10, 2021 the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) expanded the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) to include adolescents 12 through 15 years of age. Originally, the EUA permitted the use in individuals 16 years of age and older.
